- Has received a Bible Theological degree and specific training in a variety of ministries well as a minimum of 5 years pastoral experience in a local church.
- Has a cross-cultural background, specifically on the Filipino-American culture
- Meets the qualifications of an elder set forth in 1Tim 3:1-7, Titus 1:6-9 and Phil 2:5-9
- Possesses the gifts in the areas of leadership, teaching, preaching & evangelism
- Has demonstrated ability to communicate messages built on the Scriptures to groups, both small and large and also a team player.
- Married, 35-50 years old, American citizen or Permanent resident of United States of America.

Pastoral Duties
